



## Convention Timeline WFSE Convention October 9-10, 2021

DATE	Convention Timeline/Event
<b>Friday, June 11</b>	Convention Call Mailed to Locals - <b>120 days preceding the Convention</b>
<b>Friday, June 11</b>	First date that Nomination and Election of delegates/alternates can be held. 120 days prior per Appendix D, Elections Code; Article IV, Section 11.
90 days prior to the start of Convention <b>Sunday, July 11</b>	WFSE Constitution Article XVII – Amendments to the Constitution and By-Laws, Section 3. Proposals to amend the constitution by changing the Council’s per capita tax, shall be submitted to the Executive Board ninety (90) days prior to the opening of the Biennial Convention.
60 days prior to the start of Convention <b>Tuesday, August 10</b>	Executive Board’s recommendation and justification of any per capita amendments to be mailed to all affiliated locals.
60 days in advance of Convention <b>Tuesday, August 10</b>	<b>Delegate/Alternate Credentials Due into the Council Executive Office.</b> All credentials received after this date will be considered irregular and will not be considered for committee appointments. The Convention will vote on whether or not to seat the irregulars after the partial report of the Credentials Committee on the first day of the convention. Delegates whose credentials are received on or before this date will be considered regular delegates and their names, along with committee preferences will be forwarded to the Council President in order to make assignments.
<b>Tuesday, August 10</b>	Deadline to submit Delegate Committee Preferences to Executive Office.
45 days prior to the start of Convention <b>Wednesday, August 25</b>	<b>Resolutions and Constitutional Amendments</b> (other than per capita tax increases) are due on this date ( <b>45 days prior to convention</b> ). See WFSE Constitution - Article XVII – Amendments to the Constitution & By-Laws, Section 2 and Article III – Resolutions, Section 3 of the By-Laws.
<b>Monday, August 30</b>	List of Delegate Committee Preferences prepared for C28 President
<b>Thursday, September 9</b>	Resolutions and Constitutional Amendments received by the Wednesday, August 25 deadline will be provided to the Delegates/Alternates and Executive Board Members. Resolutions received after the deadline are considered “Late Resolutions” and will not be provided prior to the Convention.
30 days prior to the start of Convention <b>Thursday, September 9</b>	Committee Assignments provided to those assigned.
<b>Thursday, October 7</b>	Council 28 Executive Board Meeting
<b>Friday, October 8</b>	Registration 12:00pm – 7:00pm Convention Committee meetings 4:00pm Pre-Convention Workshop for New Delegates and Zoom Practice
<b>Saturday, October 9</b>	Registration 7:00am – 8:30am <b>Convention convenes at 9:00am</b> Officer Nominations Convention Business
<b>Sunday, October 10</b>	Council Officer Elections Convention Business and Close of Convention
